

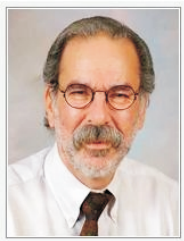

Dr. Michael Weitzman *Key Note Speaker*



Dr. Weitzman is currently Professor of Pediatrics and Psychiatry at the New York University School of Medicine where he previously served as Chair of the Department of

Pediatrics. He has conducted research and written extensively on such diverse issues as childhood lead poisoning, childhood effects of passive and prenatal exposure to cigarette smoke and ways to reduce exposure, numerous aspects of child nutrition and obesity, and the epidemiology of children's mental health problems, school failure, and asthma. He has published over 200 original articles, chapters, books and abstracts of scholarly work, and he is co-editor of two pediatric textbooks. Dr. Weitzman has won numerous awards including the 2005 Environmental Protection Agency's Children's Environmental Health Recognition Award for Protecting Children's Health by Reducing Their Exposure to Secondhand Tobacco Smoke.
